She recorded victories at multiple distances, on both turf and synthetic surfaces, and even against older horses. She recorded four wins, multiple in-the-money finishes and nearly \$100,000 in winning for her owners.

Appearing in both the Grade II Lexus Ravens Run and Orleans Stakes, she gave her owners thrills at some of the highest levels of racing.

THUNDER GULCH is best known for his Eclipse Award winning three-year-old season when he won the Grade 1 Kentucky Derby, Belmont Stakes, Travers Stakes, and Florida Derby. He is a Champion Sire of 73 Stakes Winners, 38 of those Graded including POINT GIVEN, BALANCE, CIRCULAR QUAY, SPAIN and more \$1,000,000+ winning horses. THUNDER GULCH also ranks in the top 5 of active U.S. Broodmare Sires. The first dam, PAINTBALL, has produced two runners, both winners. She was a durable runner recording wins at age 2, 3, and 4 and total earnings of \$67,700. The dosage would indicate our horse will be most effective racing extended sprints.

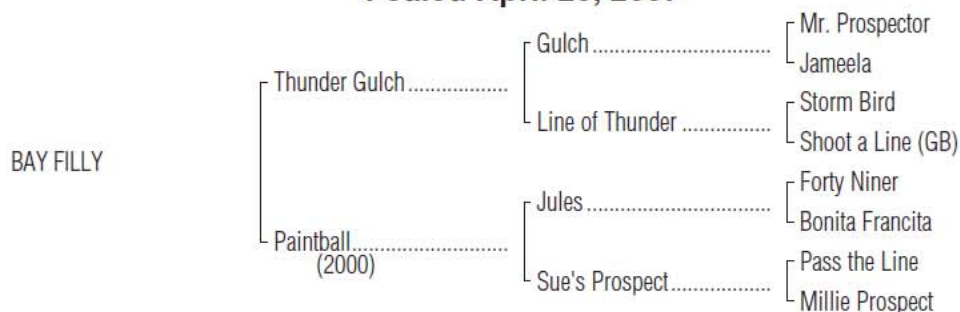
