



Name: PERPLEXITY - Filly Sire: Colonel John

Foaled: March 31, 2011 Dam: Shiny Sheet by Press Card

This filly is our first claim as a stable and represents a unique opportunity to have instant racing experience at a low-cost entry point. Perplexity is a four-year-old filly who has raced 13 times, recording one third, three second-place finishes, and two wins, earning \$48,418. Her most recent win was on February 6<sup>th</sup>, the race of our claim. During this six furlong race, she rated well and then moved past the leader to win by eight lengths, recording her career best Beyer Speed Figure, a 78, and best lifetime Brisnet speed figure, an 86. After the race she scoped well and has proven completely sound in the days following.

We have followed this filly for awhile as she is the one-year older half sister to RCR's Time Catcher. Time Catcher ran a great first race further sparking our interest. The majority of the dam's progeny (Shiny Sheet) hit their prime as four and five year olds and most don't find the winner's circle early in their three-year-old campaign. In addition, most are strong two-turn horses. We believed this filly needed to be on a fast track dirt mile to succeed. That said, she ran off the charts at six furlongs last time out, we we find ourselves a little "perplexed" ... fitting don't you think?

Her sire, Colonel John by Tiznow, sired more winners than any other second crop sire. In addition, he has been highly-ranked in his class as a stakes horse producer, siring 11 in his second crop. We believe she offers a fine late maturing racing opportunity. If interested in owning a share in Perplexity, onw will need to move promptly as she should be racing again soon and only owners share in her future purse earnings.

COLONEL JOHN was a stud on the race track. He won nearly \$1.8MM, winning at age 2, 3, and 4. He won two Grade I stakes (Travers & Santa Anita Derby) and ran second in two more. One of the few stallions to win stakes on dirt, turf and all-weather surfaces.


PERPLEXITY's dam SHINY SHEET is a graded stakes placed winner of more than \$540,000. She proved very durable, racing 33 times, winning 10 and finishing top-3 in 21 of those starts. She has produced five winners from five horses to race.
